RULES

1. Participants must be a member of Bourbon County 4-H or FFA program (s) and be 9 years old or older as of January 1st of the current show year.
2. Two participants will be selected from each species during the fair

3. week. Each winner must show his/her own animal in the showmanship contest in their respective species in order to qualify for the round robin, if they do not they will not be able to participate if chosen for the round robin. Animals will be checked to determine if they are own participants during each species shows.
3. If a Champion showman in a species has already been selected to participate in the Round Robin from a previous species another selection will be made from that species in order to have 8 participants in the Round Robin.
4. **Participants will show hogs, sheep, goats and cattle. Species winners are required to provide the animal they won with for the Round Robin.**

5. In addition to showmanship, the judge will ask a question of their choice for the participants to answer on the microphone at the end of the showmanship competition.
6. The judge will score participants on each of the four species and the question from 1 to 100. Judge will select top three placings with the highest score winning.
7. Round Robin participants can only receive Champion Showman three times in their show career. **Previous winners** who have not aged out, may participate.

Rules

1. All animals must be weighed and registered by 10:00am on day of show. Health requirements- abide by state regulations.
2. 4-H & FFA members are eligible to compete in the Open show.
3. All breeding stock must be registered by May 30 of the current year, in the name of the exhibitor. Registration papers will be checked at time of check in.
4. No 4-H & FFA bull classes
5. Market Animal Weigh in will be from 8:30am to 10:00am
6. *Anyone entering the grounds will be expected to pay \$5 admission at the main gate or at check in*
7. Any breed with **5** or more head will have their own breed, if there is not 5 head for a breed you will show in ALL OTHER BREEDS class.

Show Order- Market Animal Show, Bourbon County Market Animal Show, Breeding Female Show, and Open Bull Show.

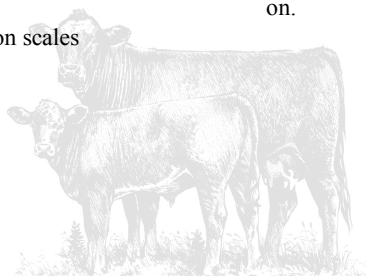
Market Animal Show- Premiums- \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5, \$5

- All market animals will be broke into classes by weight then into divisions depending on number of entries.
- Light, Medium, and Heavy Division winners will be awarded rosettes
- All steers and market heifers must be Kentucky Uniform Identification Program (KUIP) tagged.
- At time of weigh in, exhibitor must declare if heifer will be showed as market or breeding animal only can be shown as one or the other, not both.

Feeder Calf Show

- For feeder heifers or steer calves- calves must be weighed in on scales
- Steer or heifer born after January 1, 2018
- Steer or heifer weighing 300lbs- 650lbs
- Light, Medium and Heavy weight classes
- Grand & Reserve Feeder Calf Champions will be picked
