2. All animals must be on Fairgrounds by 4:00 pm.
3. Anyone in 4-H and FFA, and Others are eligible for Open Class.
4. Only blue Ribbon Animals eligible for Championship
6. There will be no more than two (2) entries per person per class

7. Showmanship entries must show in one other class.

Open to all youth.

8. All 4-H, FFA, and Novice Market lamb entries must be nominated in the exhibitors name and identified by the Kentucky Uniform Identification Program. See 4-H agent or vocational agriculture teacher for details.

9. All lambs must be shown by the exhibitor (owner) unless the exhibitor is incapacitated (deprived of strength or ability; physically impaired) or has more than one entry in a class, then he or she may have another 4-H or FFA youth exhibit his or her animal.

10. Market Lamb exhibitors will be limited to six (6) lambs. Novice exhibitors will be limited to two lambs.

11. KUIP Lambs can be shown in either breeding or market lamb classes, not both.

12. EXHIBITOR IS EXPECTED TO REMOVE ANY LIVESTOCK BEDDING THAT IS BROUGHT INTO THE FAIRGROUNDS.

13. ANYONE ENTERING GROUNDS WILL PAY ADMISSION

Youth Market lambs will be shown by breed and weight. Lambs will be split into classes of 20 lambs or less at the discretion of the show committee.

Show committee will confirm the breed of the lamb. There must be five (5) lambs in a breed to have a breed show. If five head cannot be met, lambs will be placed in either WFX or BFX classes. The decision of the show chairman and/or judge is final. Anyone failing to abide by these rules will forfeit all premium money and awards.
